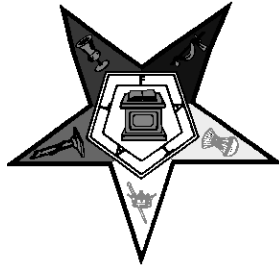

# New Lodge Building

For those members attending the lodge meetings, you know that we have received bids from the contractors to build a new lodge building. The bids were higher than we had hoped and also higher than the current offer from the Town of Normal by approximately \$100,000. The Town has increased their offer and asked that we attempt to make up the remaining deficit from member donations.

To assist us with the endeavor the Town has offered to provide us with a tax deductible path as donations directly to the lodge are not. In addition, the Illinois Lodge of Research Library and Museum is interested in moving their location to our new building. Their foundation has pledged an amount towards the new building to that end, but donations to that foundation are also tax deductible and provide an additional path to those who are interested in supporting our effort.

If you have interest in making a direct non-tax deductible donation to the building fund, you can send it to the lodge secretary. Anyone interested in finding our more information on a tax deductible gift should contact the lodge Secretary or the Worshipful Master for more information on how to proceed.

In the eventuality that we are not able to raise the needed amount and reach an agreement with the Town, donations made directly to the lodge will be placed in the lodge permanent building fund which will endow the lodge building for future repairs and maintenance. Thank you for your support.
